### Math

Students will be topic 4 in Envision math program. They will finish their study of multiplication and will begin making connections to division. Students will be learning to apply the concept of multiplication to assist them in dividing by 0-9. Students will explore odd and even patterns in multiplication and will solve word problems involving multiplication and division. Please assist your child in memorizing their multiplication facts.

### Science

In January, we will be finishing up the *Balancing Forces* unit. Students will be able to write a scientific explanation about how the floating train works.

### Reading:

In the second half of *Reading to Learning*, students will be studying narrative nonfiction with a specific focus on biographies. When the initial lessons are complete, students will be completing a biography museum project, as we finish up information writing. We are looking forward to having fun with the students.

### Writing:

Continuing the *The Art of Information Writing* unit, Students will learn to add a variety of nonfiction text features to their books as well. Students can research small additional information for a chapter or two, but the majority of these books should include information students already know. We will be publishing our books this month after putting the final edits and revisions.

### Social Studies

#### Peru

In our first country study, students will explore Peru. We will investigate the geography and government of Peru as well as its folktales and legends. We will dig deeply into the culture of Peruvian culture and how it evolved over time. We will also look at how Peru's economy meets the needs and wants of its people.
